**Daily Dispatch Felt Cycle Tour**

Date: Sunday 26 February 2012

Time: From 06h25

Start/Finish: Esplanade Road, on the beachfront

Compulsory Registration: Cycle Tour Expo, at the Osner Hotel, Esplanade Rd on Friday 24 February 10am – 6pm &amp; Saturday 25 February 9 – 3pm

Distance: 100 km Cycle Tour, 46km Fun Ride

Seeding: The Daily Dispatch Felt Cycle Tour is a seeding event for the Cape Argus Pick 'n Pay Cycle Tour 2013, the Pick 'n Pay 94.7 Cycle Challenge 2012 and other major national cycling events. Cyclists will be seeded according to specific criteria as set out at the discretion of the organisers.

Substitutions: You may not sell your number, or allow anyone else to ride under that number.

Timing: RACETEC is the Official Timing System for the Daily Dispatch Felt Cycle Tour. Please note you will need to purchase your RACETEC chip at a fee over and above the cost of the entry fee.

This can be done at registration. You may also purchase RACETEC Chips through a Cape Argus Pick 'n Pay Cycle Tour Seeding Event.

You will need a Timing Chip to obtain an official time.

Cut off time: Participants must complete the course in 6 hours or less in order to qualify as finishers and to receive a medal. Support vehicles and marshals will be withdrawn after the cut off time. There will be a cut off time of 3hrs 30min at the halfway mark.

Results: A full set of results will be available on the website. The results will be published in The Daily Dispatch in the week following the event (Note that these results will be provisional).

Prize Money: Prize money to the value of R30 000-00 will be paid. Full details on the website. Note that in terms of CSA rules, prize money may only be paid to Cyclists Licenced with CSA. Lucky draw prizes are available to all participants.

Medals: All finishers receive a medal on completion of the route within the time limit

Water Points: See map for the positions of the water points. Water and Powerade will be available.

Age: No cyclist under the age of 17 years old (on race day) are permitted to enter the 100km Cycle Tour

No cyclist under the age of 12 years old (on race day) are permitted to enter the 100km or 46km Cycle Tour

Prize Giving: Will take place at approximately 12h00 outside the Osner Hotel

Distance: 65 km, 30km and 10km

Age: Cyclists under the age of 12 years old (on race day) must be accompanied by an adult

Prize Giving: 11am at Nahoon Dam

**Spur Mini Tour**

Start/Finish: Esplanade Road, outside the Osner Hotel

Registration/Entries: Friday 24 February 10am – 6pm or Saturday 25 February 9am – 12 pm or at the start line in front of the Osner Hotel from 12 – 1:30 pm

Distance: 5km Mini Tour, 1km Scooter dash

Age: 5km - Group1: 5-8yrs, Group2: 9-12yrs

1km Kids Scooter Dash - 2-5yrs (parents welcome)

Note: Ride is undertaken at your own risk with parental approval. Helmets are compulsory.

All kiddies riding receive a goodie bag at registration, medals are only for children.

All parents pay to ride or you are welcome to walk along side your child

**Ice - Cream Cart Charity Challenge**

Distance: 8km. 4 riders each to ride 2km and to change riders at designated points along the route

Age: Age: no cyclist under the age of 18 years old (on race day) are permitted to enter

**Rules (Cycle Tour, Ice- Cream Cart Charity Challenge and MTB events)**

\* Pro registered teams are allowed 1 support vehicle. (Cycle Tour)

\* Cyclists need to enter before 11 Feb to obtain seeding

- Entry fees are not refundable under any circumstances
- On completion of their ride participants must not ride their bicycles anywhere near the finish line
- Any rider who decides to change the distance he/she is riding must inform the race organizers at least 1 day before the start.
- Every rider shall ride carefully and with due regard to the safety of other cyclists and other road users.
- Every rider shall wear a bicycle helmet with the strap securely fastened under his/her chin.
- Every rider shall immediately comply with the instructions of a marshal and/or a traffic officer.
- A rider shall not ride a bicycle fitted with triathlon, time trial or Spinachi-type bars.
- A rider may not use a personal music system or a radio communication device, including a cellular phone, whilst riding except that members of professional teams may use a radio communication device.
- A rider shall not use foul or offensive language to his/her fellow riders or to any marshal.
- A rider shall not dispose of any litter along the course except in refuse bins.
- A rider may not start or attempt to start before his/her designated start.
- You may not ride in reverse direction on the route, even after finishing.
- A rider shall endeavour to complete the course with his/her own effort and shall not receive any assistance in this regard other than drafting behind another rider or riders participating in the Cycle tour.
- A rider shall provide reasonable assistance to any other rider involved in an accident while participating in the Cycle tour.
- A rider shall be responsible to other riders for the proper control of his/her bicycle.
- A licensed rider shall in addition comply with all applicable UCI rules and regulations.
- A rider may not participate whilst under the influence of alcohol or any drug or medication that prevents or might prevent a rider from properly controlling his/her bicycle.
- A rider may not use performance enhancing drugs. A rider (other than a licensed rider) is not subject to anti-doping testing, except that any rider may be tested for alcohol or drugs after an accident.
- A rider shall not display on his/her bicycle, clothing and cycling equipment and writing, logo or item that is offensive or that may bring the Cycle Tour into disrepute, as determined by the Cape Town Cycle Tour Trust.
- A rider who is informed by a marshal that he/she has been disqualified shall immediately slow down and cease to ride with the group that he or she was riding with at the time of the disqualification. A rider so disqualified shall thereafter cease to race but may thereafter ride the course only with permission of the marshal but may not cross the finish line or mats.
- Every rider entering the Cycle Tour consents to his/her name and/or number being publicly displayed and publicised (including on the internet) in the event that he/she is disqualified.
- The Tour will take place regardless of bad weather and will only be cancelled, re-routed or stopped for reasons of safety.
- Cyclists are required to stop should they consume water at a water point.
